Martindale Hall, gifted to the people of South Australia through the Mortlock family, is at risk of being lost to the public forever.

The State Government is promoting an 'unsolicited bid' to create an exclusive 'wellness resort' there, handing over the Hall, Coach House and grounds to a private partnership. Built in 1880, the Hall in Mintaro is the much loved star of the classic Australian film [Picnic at Hanging Rock](#) and one of the most important heritage buildings in South Australia.

In December 2014, the Government denied it had any plans to sell the building. That has now changed, with Minister Ian Hunter saying all options are now on the table, although no formal expressions of interest or tenders have been called. Sadly, it is the same Minister who is charged with the custodianship of the State's heritage assets who is now spruiking for the privatisation of one of the State's unique heritage treasures.

Our heritage is at greater risk than ever from a Government that seems to think everything is for sale, even those things that were gifted to the people.
